7. Method of competitions:

Round-robin system in the preliminary rounds / single elimination system in the quarter-finals, semi-finals and final

1) Six (6) national teams will be seeded in the preliminary rounds. They are the host city, and the top five (5) highest-ranked teams at the most recent 2007 WTF World Taekwondo Championships that are participating in this championships. If any of the seeded nations is not participating, the next-highest ranked team at the 2007 WTF World Taekwondo Championships that is participating will be seeded.

2) In the preliminary round, 24 teams will be classified into six (6) groups, with four (4) teams per group. Each of the top six (6) seeded teams will be classified in one group. The rest of the teams will be randomly assigned to the groups during the drawing of lots session. If deemed necessary to change this drawing system due to change of number of participating teams, etc, Technical Delegate can make final decision and will announce at the Head of Team meeting.

- 3) Based on round-robin system, each team will play three (3) times in the preliminary round.
- 4) The top team of each group will automatically advance to the quarter-final round, i.e. there will be six (6) automatic quarterfinalists. The other two (2) quarterfinal slots will be allocated to two (2) teams with the 'Best records' among the second-placed teams.

In the case of a tie, the second-placed teams with the best records shall be determined as follows (in the order of priority):

- i. Team with the most number of team victories
- ii. Team with the most number of individual victories
- iii. Team that scores the most number of K.O.
- iv. Team that has the least number of withdrawal of individual matches
- v. Team with the most number of individual points scored
- vi. Teams with less 'Gam-jeom's
- vii. Teams with less 'Kyong-go's

If there is still a tie after exhausting the above criteria, the second-placed teams with the best records shall be determined by the method decided by Technical Delegate in consultation with Competition Supervisory Board.

- 5) If there are only two teams that are tied for first place, then the top-ranked team is the winner of the head-to-head match between these two teams in the pertinent competition.
- 6) If there are more than two teams in the same group that are tied for first place, then the best record shall be determined as follows (in the order of priority):
 - i. Team with the most number of individual victories
 - ii. Team that scores the most number of K.O.
 - iii. Team that has the least number of withdrawal of individual matches
 - iv. Team with the most number of individual points scored
 - v. Teams with less 'Gam-jeom's
 - vi. Teams with less 'Kyong-go's

If there is still a tie after exhausting the above criteria, the second-placed teams with the best records shall be determined by the method decided by Technical Delegate in consultation with Competition Supervisory Board.

- 7) In case that there are less than 24 teams participating per male or female division, the number of groups and number of teams per group may be subject to change. In this case, the Technical Delegate shall make the final decision and will announce the decision at the Head of Team meeting.
- 8) There will be random drawing of lots among eight (8) quarter-finalists for the next stage.
- 9) Even if one team achieves a majority of victories and has won the team match, the remaining individual matches should also be completed.
- 10) Contestants shall compete against opposing contestant of the same weight division.

10. Award presentation (Male and Female team respectively)

- 1st place: Cup to the team and Gold medals to athletes of pertinent team
- 2nd place: Cup to the team and Silver medals to athletes of pertinent team
- 3rd place (2 teams): Cup to the team and Bronze medals to athletes of pertinent team

* The first team athletes and/or substituted athletes of the team who were identified in the entry shall win the certain ranking points equally on the basis of the points the pertinent team achieved provided that they compete at least once. In addition, the first team athletes and substituted athletes of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd ranked teams will all receive medals provided that the athletes' eligibility for participation was verified by the WTF through the procedures such as registration and weigh-in.

11. Conditions for participation

- 1) Round trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating national team.
- 2) Entry fee of US\$300 for each male and female team shall be enclosed in the entry form. Bank references will be provided by the organizing committee in due time. All bank drafts shall be made payable to the following account:

12. International Referees

- 1) The WTF will appoint the required number of International Referees.
- 2) Round trip airfare shall be borne by each participating international referee, while the Organizing Committee will cover accommodation of room and board for the designated period.
- 3) The Organizing Committee will provide the participating referees with daily allowances of US\$100 for the course of the competitions.

13. WTF-recognized taekwondo uniform (Dobok) and protective equipment

- 1) Participating contestants must wear the WTF-recognized taekwondo uniform and the WTF-recognized protective equipment, including the head protectors, trunk protectors, gloves, shin and forearm guards, and the groin guards.
- 2) The organizing committee will provide head protectors and trunk protectors for the participating contestants, while participating contestants are required to bring the groin guard, gloves, and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- 3) All contestants are required to proceed to the inspection desk for official to check their uniform and protective equipment before entering into the competition area. Any contestant wearing unofficial taekwondo uniform or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.
- 4) The list of companies for the WTF-recognized taekwondo uniform and protective equipment is enclosed herein for purchase in advance. The updated list can be found in WTF website at any time.

14. Medical control

- 1) Use of drugs or any other doping offences by chemical substances is strictly prohibited.
- 2) The WTF will carry out random medical doping tests among the participating athletes. Any athletes who refuse to undergo the tests or who is proven to have committed a breach of the regulation, shall be removed from the final standing, and shall be subject to disciplinary actions.
- 3) The Anti-Doping Rules of the World Taekwondo Federation and/or the World Anti-Doping Code shall apply.
- 4) Please find attached herewith the Therapeutic Use Exemptions Form for Taekwondo. If an athlete needs to apply for a TUE, he or she has to submit the form to the Anti-Doping Division (antidoping@wtf.org or +82.2.553.4728) **by no later than 21 days before** the start of the 2009 WTF World Cup Taekwondo Team Championships. No TUE will be accepted after May 20, 2009.

Note: In accordance with the 2009 WADA Code and WTF Anti-Doping Rules, there will no longer be Abbreviated TUE applications.

15. WEIGH-IN

- 1) Weigh-in for contestants (including the substituted athletes) of all weight divisions shall be completed one (1) day before the championships. Therefore, the weigh-in will be held on June 10, 2009.
- 2) During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. Contestants may also choose to conduct the weigh-in without any clothing on.

16. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION

- 1) The head of team meeting and the drawing of lots session shall be conducted two (2) day prior to the start of the championships, in the presence of the WTF officials and the representatives of the participating nations. The drawing of lots shall be done in an ascending order of the weight divisions (i.e. from the lightest to the heaviest weight divisions).
- 2) The order of the draw may be changed depending on the decision of the Technical Delegate, upon consultation with the participating officials at the Head of Team meeting:
- 3) Depending on the decision of the Technical Delegate, WTF officials or Organizing Committee volunteers could be designated to draw lots on behalf of the officials of the participating nations who are not present at the time of the lot drawing session.

17. Indemnities

The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that their participants have validly completed and signed the official participation forms, thus indemnifying the organizers, its officials and other contestants from any claims of injuries, losses, fatalities or otherwise arising in the course of participation in this championships or any activities thereto.

- 1) The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.
- 2) Participants without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.
- 3) The Organizing Committee will acquire general insurance, at its own expenses, for the contestants and staffs, in the event of any injury that may arise during the course of the championships.

18. Closing date for entries

The closing date for the Organizing Committee to receive the entry is April 30, 2009. This entry form will be sent by Organizing Committee in due time. Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.

19. Others

- 1) Each participating nation should bring two national flags (size: 90cm x 130cm) as well as a CD or cassette tape of its national anthem.
- 2) All contestants and officials participating in 2009 WTF World Cup Taekwondo Team Championships will receive a diploma co-signed by the WTF President and the Chairman of the Organizing Committee.

20. Visa matters

- 1) The visa is possible to get at Azerbaijan Embassy in abroad or upon arrival to Heydar Aliyev International airport. To secure the process it is better to ask invitation letter from Azerbaijan Taekwondo Federation before arrival.
